In this sense the BiGSEM agenda aspires to expose doctoral students early to the frontiers of international research and to help them to develop their own research agenda, by providing doctoral and research seminars and encouraging and supporting participation at international conferences and exchange visits within the extensive cooperation network with renowned international partners. To promote cross-disciplinary training of doctoral students and thereby to invest in internationally recognized and unique qualifications, in 2012 BiGS-EM became part of the newly founded Bielefeld Graduate School in Theoretical Science (BGTS), an umbrella organization for various research (training) programs at Bielefeld University set up by the Faculties of Mathematics.
